
#### First Class Suggested Work 19th June





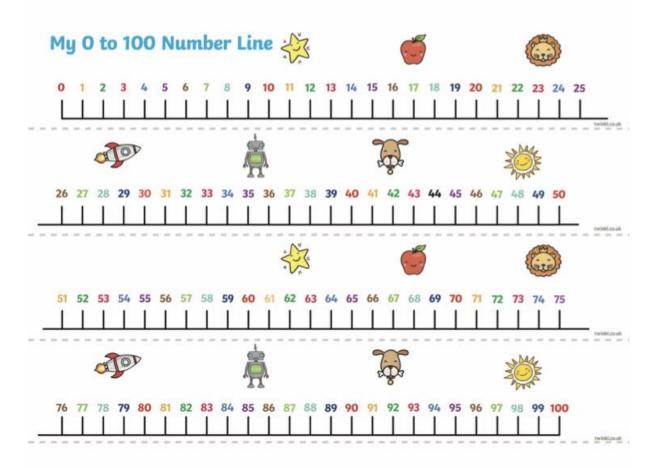
